The game got really exciting as they made smart moves and tried to outsmart each other. Kara made a daring move and captured one of Jack's kings, which gave her an advantage.

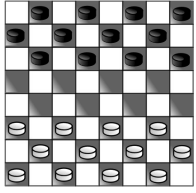
In the end, Kara won the game! They all clapped and cheered for her victory. Kara and Jack were happy and proud of their first day playing checkers together.

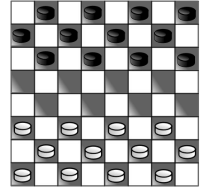

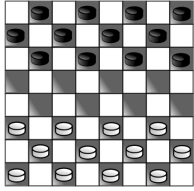
Finally, after what felt like hours of intense concentration, Chloe made her last move. She jumped over Matt's final piece and proudly crowned one of her pieces as king.

"I win!" Chloe shouted with joy, jumping up from her chair and doing a little victory dance.

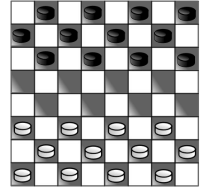
Matt grinned and extended his hand. "Congratulations, Chloe! You're the Checkers Champion today."

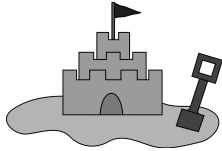

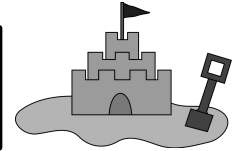

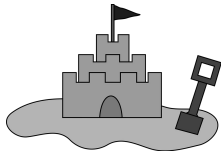
They had a picnic on the blanket with sandwiches and fruit. Emma shared stories about her sandcastle adventures.

After lunch, Emma and her dad explored tide pools, finding small sea creatures like hermit crabs. They also walked along the shore, collecting seashells.

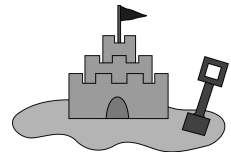
