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Dear Parents,

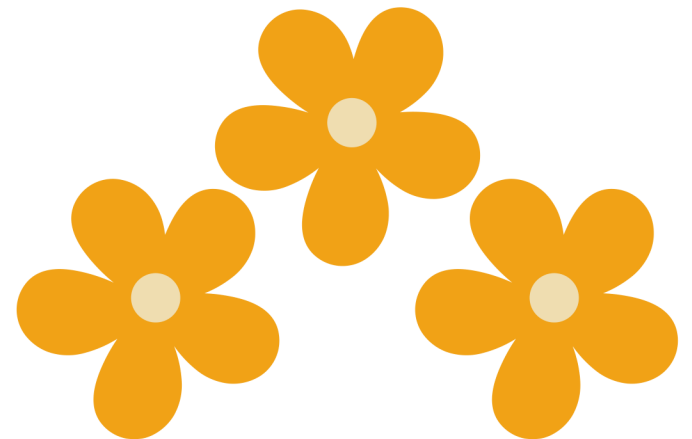
We have been working very hard on your child's articulation skills during this school year. It is important for your child to practice throughout the summer break in order to maintain the progress he or she has made so far.
